Express Scripts Pharmacy

Express Scripts has a network of nearly 60,000 independent and chain pharmacies nationwide. When you visit a participating pharmacy, you will receive up to a 30-day supply after paying the applicable cost share (or a 90-day supply of maintenance medications through the Smart90 Program). Remember to take your Express Scripts ID card with you.

Sign up online at express-scripts.com/rx and download the Express Scripts Pharmacy app to your mobile device. You can easily manage your prescriptions, make payments, request refills, and check the status of your order.

Specialty Medications

Specialty drugs are medications that require special handling, administration, or monitoring – these are often given by injection. Your provider will let you know if a medication you are prescribed is considered a specialty drug. Specialty medications must be filled through **Accredo**.

Visit accredo.com and click “*Find a Medication*” to get started.

Please note, if you take a specialty medication, you are not automatically enrolled with Accredo Specialty Pharmacy.

SaveOnSP

To help lower the high cost of specialty medications, Air Group’s plan includes a copay assistance benefit through SaveOnSP. Nearly 400 specialty drugs for conditions such as hepatitis C, multiple sclerosis, psoriasis, inflammatory bowel disease, rheumatoid arthritis, and cancer are eligible. If you fill an eligible prescription, SaveOnSP will contact you to complete enrollment. By participating, you will pay a reduced cost for your medication; if you choose not to enroll, you will pay a higher coinsurance.
